Section 1 (Introduction) c. is hereby revised to read as follows:

The contract period shall be from Notice to Proceed and all goods and materials must be delivered within sixty (60) days after Notice to Proceed.

Section 2 (Products), b. (Rail Materials) i. is hereby revised to read as follows:

Provide one hundred four (104), six (6) hole Joint Bars for 140lb rail, with a hole pattern of: 7-6-5 ½-6-7 (inches).

Section 2 (Products), b. (Rail Materials) ii. is hereby revised to read as follows:

Provide one-thousand, one hundred forty-four (1,144) Double Shoulder Tie Plates with six (6) inch base, eight (8) holes, and a minimum dimension of 8" X 13".

Section 2 (Products), c. (Rail Switches and RR Ties), i. is hereby revised to read as follows:

Provide a Number 11, Right-Hand Turnout for 136-140 # rail, heavy industrial AREMA spec. with 16'6" knife points, adjustable Plates and braces, RBM frog with guard rails, Racor 22 E with alternating green and yellow target and bow handle. Rail tie kit for turnout should be included. Do not include rail for turnouts.

Section 2 (Products), c. (Rail Switches and RR Ties), ii. is hereby revised to read as follows:

Provide a Number 11, Left- Hand Turnout for 136-140 # rail, heavy industrial AREMA spec. with 16'6" knife points, adjustable Plates and braces, RBM frog with guard rails, Racor 22 E with alternating green and yellow target and bow handle. Rail tie kit for turnout should be included. Do not include rail for turnouts.

Section 2 (Products), e. (Delivery) ii. Is hereby revised to read as follows:

The starting date is upon receipt of Notice to Proceed and the completion date for the delivery of the materials and components shall be sixty (60) days from Notice to Proceed.

Section 4 (Invoicing and Payment Requirements) a. is hereby revised to read as follows:

The Bidder shall submit an itemized invoice to the PCPA address upon contract award.

Section 4 (Invoicing and Payment Requirements) b. is hereby revised to read as follows:

The Bidder shall be paid in accordance with the firm, fixed prices stated on the pricing page of this document upon contract award, and acceptance by PCPA.

Section 7 (Bid Guaranty/Contract Bond) is amended as follows:

- 1. No bid bond shall be required for this project.**
- 2. Bidders may bid individual line items.**

All other provisions of section 7, including the requirement for a performance bond shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 9 is added to read as follows:

- 9.1 **Cost Determination** – The low bid shall be determined by reviewing each line item separately.
- 9.2 **Contract Award** – The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive Bidder determined as specified above.
 - a. Award of this bid will be made on an “Item-By-Item” basis after reviewing all options, and by using the lowest responsive bid, providing the prices are acceptable to the PCPA.
 - b. In the event of tie low bids, the Port Commission reserves the right to establish the method to be used in determining the award.
 - c. Bidders may bid individual line items.
